NOTES FROM NORM AT THE FARM

Lots of friends have asked me how I am getting along without him here at JFF:

- 2. Have hauled no water in the past 6 months to cattle. This is a dividend from the water works we have installed over the past 18 months. Currently all JFF livestock have access to water that is piped to them.
- 3. We have experienced one of the top 10 warmest / driest January's, on record.

When we have an average or cold/wet winter, there is always work created by the weather. This year we have been able to make use of warm, sunny days and get tasks done that would normally be waiting for spring.

BIRD WATCHING

The snowy owl has taken up residence on the south side of Elbing, near Berean Academy. This is 1.5 miles east of its initial location when first sighted about 8 weeks ago.

I have also seen a bald eagle here at JFF, twice in the past week. And according to staff at Elbing Grain, there may be an eagle's nest at Harvey County East Lake, about 5 miles to the west.

Lots of Canada and Snow geese in the hood. Several hundred are usually at the pond, or nearby, part of the day.

HERD & CROP NEWS

We will move the cow herd onto wheat pasture in the coming week in preparation for calving to start about April 1. Also had a couple families out for a tour during the nice weather in January. And the herd looks great.

Crop prospects for the coming growing season are greatly improved with 2.5" rain received on Feb 3 & 4. Long-term forecasts indicate the drought will continue for parts of the southwest USA.
